The purpose of CYCLE RCT is to determine whether critically ill, mechanically ventilated patients recover faster if they receive early in-bed cycling in addition to routine physiotherapy (PT). Following informed consent, patients will be randomized to receive 30 minutes/day of cycling and routine PT interventions or routine PT interventions alone. This will continue throughout their ICU stay (for up to 28 days), unless complications arise. Patients will also receive strength and function assessments at ICU awakening, ICU discharge, 3 days post-ICU discharge, and hospital discharge; our physiotherapists will administer these tests. Research staff will complete short questionnaires with the patients at ICU discharge, hospital discharge, and a short telephone call 90 days post-enrollment.
